- Description of facility where rodents are housed
- Description of sentinel program and any disease outbreaks in the past 12 months
- Serology and Bacteriology
- Fecal/Intestinal Parasites/Ecto-parasites Assessment

NOTE: Animals infected with or exposed to rodent pinworms will no longer be accepted

RODENTS FROM FACILITIES EXPOSED TO THE FOLLOWING PATHOGENS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED INTO MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS ANIMAL RESOURCES UNLESS REDERIVED – Certain ecto- and endo-parasites, parvovirus, C. bovis and Pneumocystis spp.

Importation of rodents to MSU is only by approval from CAR Veterinary Staff.

All rodents coming from non-approved sources must follow the established CAR quarantine process. PI is responsible for additional costs of rodent quarantine and shipping charges. See CAR website for current Import service charges.
